

## What Happened Next?

- Mahalia Jackson performed at Carnegie Hall in New York City in 1950.
- She toured Europe in 1952, but fell ill and had to return to the United States for a tumor to be removed.
- She appeared on Ed Sullivan's TV show in 1953, started a series of radio programs on CBS in 1954, and began to record with Columbia Records.
- She performed at events in support of the civil rights movement, including the famous March on Washington in 1963.
- She published her autobiography, *Movin' on Up*, in 1966.
- She died on January 27, 1972, in Chicago.
- In 1998, the US Postal Service issued a stamp in her honor.
